P.L.A.Y. After School Program-*Learning through play*



Imaginary play offers children the opportunity to learn about real life situations and practice social skills.

P.L.A.Y. stands for Positive Lifestyle Activities for Youth, and one of the focuses of this after school enrichment program at the R.S.C.C. is fostering positive social and emotional development. Children learn to solve problems, express emotions, and build important communication skills when they interact with their peers, and we

believe these skills are best practiced through play. This program is offered Tue-Fri, during the school year, and is open to students in grades K-5. Participants also engage in group games, physical activities, and creative projects, and are provided homework help and a nutritious snack. P.L.A.Y. is a licensed school age childcare program.

This year, our Zone Program for teens has experienced steady growth, and increased participation indicates the program success, as we are having an average of 30 teens attend the Zone Program regularly on Friday nights. Also popular with the teens involved in the Zone Program is our monthly "Coffee House Night," which is held on the last Friday of every month.

This regular event offers local teens a place to hang out with friends and try a specialty coffee drink or pastry, while enjoying musical entertainment and social interaction with peers and mentors in a safe "teen-friendly" space.

The Zone Program is held every Friday night from 7 to 10pm and students in grades 7-12 from all local schools are invited to attend.
